- 24 youthworkers from 8 countries.



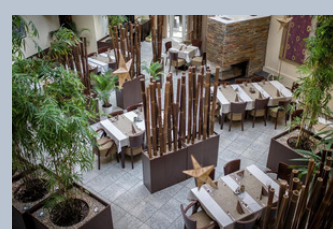
PARTICIPANTS

OBJECTIVES

By implementing the project we want to:

- 1) deepen participants' knowledge and understanding of non-formal education,
- 2) improve participants' understanding of social inclusion and inclusive approach in youth work,
- 3) enhance skills of designing and facilitating activities fit for specific groups,
- 4) Creating a safe space for exchanging experience, struggles and best practices.
